General Information

PB Valley Estate is located 150 km's northeast of Bangkok a comfortable drive of less than two hours from Bangkok Metropolis on a 6 lane highway.

PB Valley is situated on the edge of the Khao Yai National Park and is the birthplace of the Khao Yai wine region.

Visiting the **PB Valley Estate** and the Khao Yai region is possible all year around as this mountainous region northeast of Bangkok is always a few degrees cooler than Bangkok. But similar to all of Thailand the best time for travelers is November to March which is the dry or so called winter season.

⇒ The **PB Valley Vineyards** are open to visitors daily from 08.30 am to 04:30 pm

⇒ The Entrance is free

Please note that the harvest time of all PB Valley wines is from end of January to end of March but table grapes are grown and harvested all year round

Transportation

The following stations of public services are located about 8km's away from our estate:

- ⇒ Hourly public bus departing from the Northern Bus Terminal in Bangkok (Morchit) to Muak Lek where you have to disembark at the **Or Sor Kor bus stop**
- ⇒ Hourly Mini Van Service departing from the Victory Monument Bangkok to Muak Lek where you have to disembark at the **Muak Lek Market**
- ⇒ A train of the State Railway of Thailand departing Bangkok at the Hua Lampong terminal to **Muak Lek Station**

A New 'Home' for World-class Wines

Traditionally, grapes for wine-making have been grown between the 30th and 50th parallels in both the northern and southern hemispheres.

Thailand has pioneered wine production in a narrow band in the north between the 14th to 18th parallels.

Years of research, testing and development have opened up new frontiers in viticulture resulting in

'New Latitude Wines'

Premium wines made from grapes grown in the exotic tropical latitude of 14.3 degrees north.

Our History

In 1989, Dr. Piya Bhirombhakdi - a visionary entrepreneur with a great appreciation for the finest things in life set about his mission to produce wine with a world-class taste for the people of Thailand. In the pioneering years of Thai wine-making history, this was indeed a very significant challenge.

The first vineyard spread over a total of 20 hectares and was planted with Shiraz for the red wine and Chenin Blanc for the white, featuring French rootstock, and Tempranillo from Spain. With the harvest of 1998, PB Valley Khao Yai Winery celebrated its first milestone.

The 1999 vintage proved that quality wine could be successfully produced in Thailand.

The first marketing success followed soon after and the vision of Dr. Piya Bhirombhakdi had become reality.

When Khao Yai Winery started it was the only wine maker in the region, however as more wineries emerged it was felt inappropriate to use the regional name on its wine labels. Thus Khao Yai wine has been renamed PB Valley wine after the owners initials.

The logo of the hornbill sitting on a cluster of grapes has an interesting cultural significance. The bird does not feast on grapes during the harvest as the logo could suggest, but is a symbol of Khao Yai National Park.

The Hornbills habitat is one with fertile forests and the bird is a sign of fertility for which it was selected as the symbol of the vineyard.

In the next four to five years PB Valley plans to expand to different varieties of grapes in order to produce a PB Valley Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon, Dornfelder and Zinfandel wines.

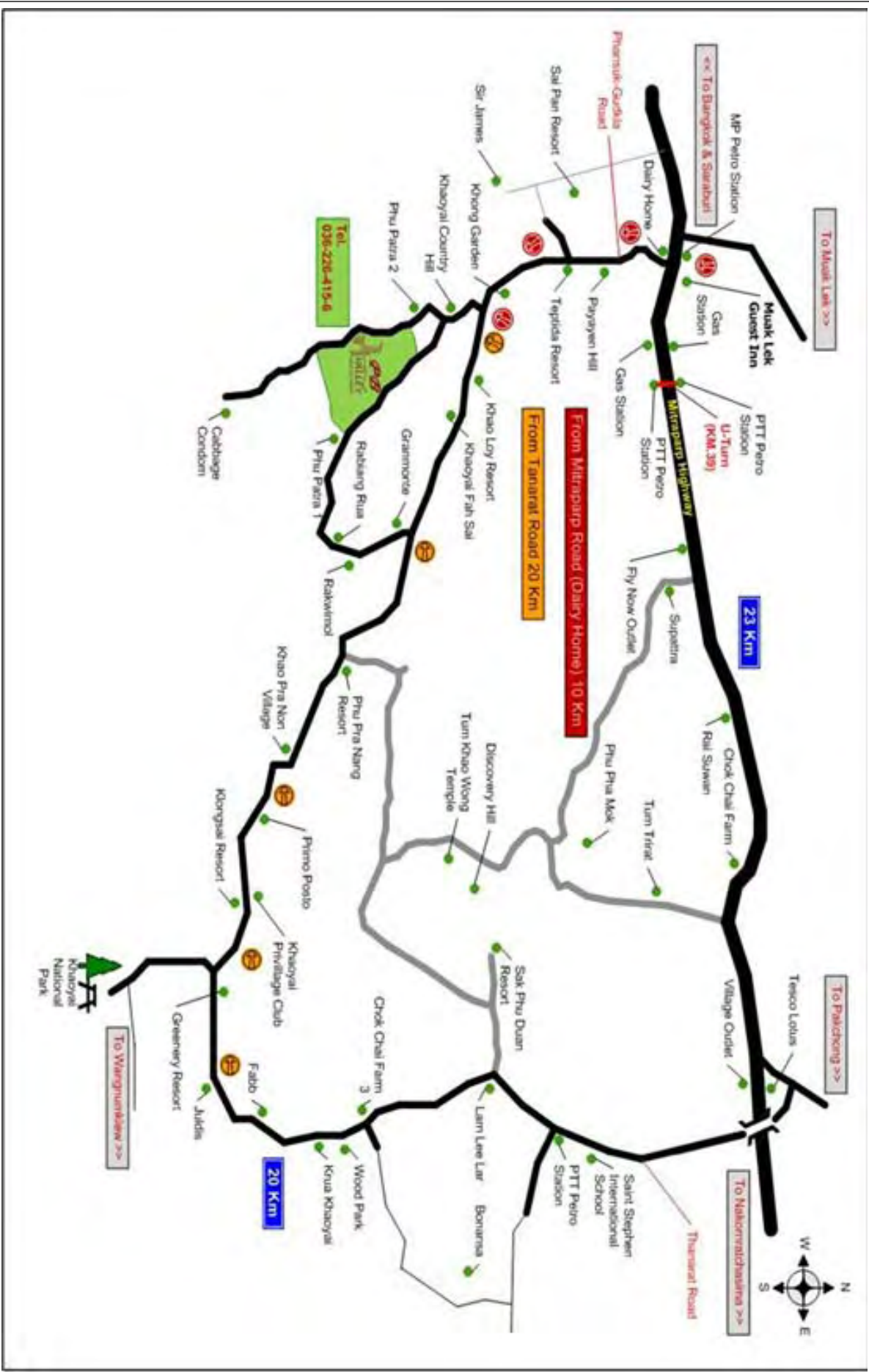

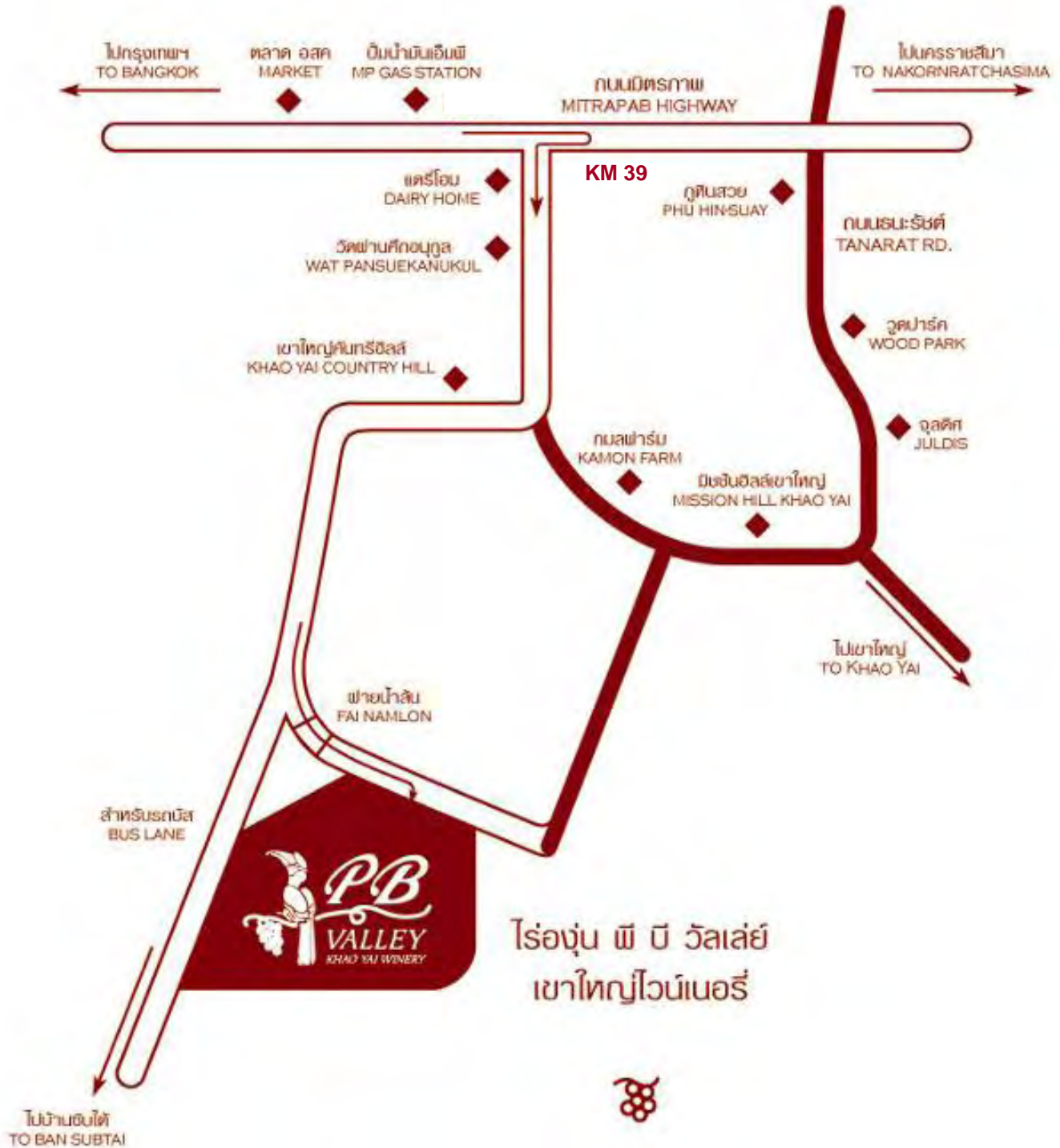

Driving directions to PB Valley Estate

From almost anywhere in BKK

- Take expressway or any other road direction to Din Daeng and take elevated Toll Way to Don Muang Airport and onwards to Rangsit (after airport)
- Follow the highway no 1 to Saraburi
- At Saraburi (km 106) turn right into the highway 2 to Nakorn Ratchasima
- Follow this highway up the hills to the **Muak Lek** Intersection at km 35
- Continue straight on for 4 km
- On the right hand side at km 39 is a **PTT Gasoline Station**
- When at this gasoline station make a **U-Turn**
- After the U-turn keep on the left for about 2.7 km's and turn into the road on the left side.
- At the corner is the Dairy Home restaurant
- Follow the road for about 5 km's by following the signs of PB-Valley, Phu Patra Real Estate and Cabbage & Condom Resort.
- After about 5 km's turn right still following the same signs
- After about another 2 km's you will reach a fork in the road
- Take the left side for cars and follow for another kilometer thereafter where you will reach the gate of the PB Valley Estate at the right hand side.
- Drive up to the Great Hornbill Grill where our staff will take care of you.

Remark:

In case your home or starting point is near the **outer ring** west or east - then take the outer ring to the Bang-Pa-In intersection and go onto Saraburi on Highway 1 the rest as above.

In 1998, he graduated in Viniculture and Oenology at Lehr-und Versuchsanstalt fuer Weinbau und Obstbau Weinsberg (LVWO). He returned to Thailand and became Thailand's first winemaker and was subsequently appointed the position of manager of the Winery, as well.

Wines produced under the supervision of Prayut have been served on board Thai International Airways in economy, business and first class. His most recent achievements having the wines of PB Valley Khao Yai Winery selected to be served at the gala dinners hosted by the Thai Prime Minister for the Heads of States at the APEC 2003 and 2010 conferences in Bangkok and Pattaya.

Several of wines have been awarded at the various AWC Austrian Wine Challenges which are the largest blind tastings worldwide held every year in Vienna / Austria.

Heribert Gaksch began his career with an apprenticeship in the bakery at the hotel of his parents in Reit im Winkl, a summer and winter resort in Germany's Bavarian Alps.

He then went on to learn the international hotel industry, working in various positions in hotels in Germany, Turkey and Thailand, and with such chains as Intercontinental and Sheraton, until he became General Manager of the Tawana Ramada hotel in Bangkok, Thailand.

In June 1992, he took over the helm of LSG Siam Flight Services and took this pioneering operation to a whole new level, going from 1,200 meals a day to an average of 8,500, and from 6 international airline customers to 17, jumping from a staff of 120 to 430.

In 1998 he started LSG's catering operations in Yangon, Myanmar from scratch while continuing his role in Bangkok. At the same time, on behalf of LSG, he provided consulting for ACS Air Catering Services Ltd., in Phnom Penh, Cambodia.
